# Viking Rune



Lesson {2} Uruz

[2] Uruz<sup>1</sup> (U) or Ur | strength | wild ox, "Auroch" | Anglo-Saxon "cattle" | rain or water

## **Runes include the following information:**

Q: What do the runes really mean? "Runa" is a Gothic word for secret or mystery.

A way for the Vikings (Leif Erikson) to record the details surrounding specific events that involved the poisoning of others.

What is the secret or mystery of Uruz? See if students can answer this question.

A1: Explanation of who, what, where, why and when.

A2: An alphabet (if used correctly) that can be interpreted by others.

Anything to translate?

The cave art was found in "Qurta" Egypt, when they were on their way to Uzbekistan.

The Explanation: QWERTY


The W (water) changes to a U (Ur). The auroch thought it was water, but it was frozen Uranium. Kali wasn't paying attention, claimed Deneb's spaceship was hovering overhead at the time. Possibly due to the appearance of an ancient giant known to the Norse as Surtr<sup>2</sup>. (see pic below)

An "E" is added for elephant (Surtr), the Norse fire-giant that startled them.

*The Y changes to an A (Adam). Adam was the would-be secret keeper of this incident, but never really said due to their arrogance and conceit.*

The *auroch* is an extinct cattle species,<sup>4</sup> considered to be the wild ancestor of modern domestic cattle. The auroch is/was originally native to England and Ireland...Europe and Central Asia...Domestication of the auroch began around 2,000 BC. Uruz is proto-Germanic for "*auroch*," or "*wild ox*," and Anglo-Saxon for "*cattle*." "*Aur*" and "*ur*" are Germanic and Celtic words, repsectively that mean "*wild ox*." The Old High German words  $\bar{u}r$  (*primordial*) and *ohso* for (*ox*) were compounded to form  $\bar{u}rohso$ , which became the early modern "*auroch*" or "*primordial ox*."



At the end of the Stone Age, "Kali5" (with her twin sibling, Tenko and her younger brother Brocken, at the time) draws two aurochs (a male and a female) on a rocky outcrop in the Qurta region of Egypt. They continue towards the Caspian Sea Region (part of the way by boat) where they eventually discover ice and a blue uranium pool in what is now present-day Uzbekistan. The female auroch licks salt from the ice while Brocken stands watching.

The next morning, the sun is shining on the horizon, and the male auroch takes a drink from the Ur pool, perhaps thinking it's water and becomes poisoned with *Ur*. Kali was distracted by Deneb's spaceship hovering in the area, and the Auroch ended up drinking from the Pool, contaminating the Ur with its *tongue*. As a result, the Ur needed to be cleaned or sifted before use, or anyone who uses it will grow an extended tongue, or branch or anything else it might be contaminated with.

Around this time they also being to domesticate the *Auroch*. *Ur* is named after the *Auroch* cattle species due to the U-shape of their horns.

This is possibly the first naming and documented instance of *Ur* discovery and *Ur* poisoning in recorded history.

(Gaia) possibly named her son (Uranus) after the auroch, or he was named after Ur/ Uranium...meaning that Gaia's son/consort was named "<u>primordial anus</u>."

↑ The Auroch is/was a still "alive<sup>6</sup>," poisoned with Ur from the Blue Sapphire Pool. The male Auroch is left in Gaia's cave (presumably in Ireland along the coast) with a Bow (the bow (only the wooden/stick part) was left there later by Feanor - see #27 "Bow")

Eventually, the auroch is returned to Ireland,  $\uparrow$  still "alive," and sinks into Gaia's cave along the western coast (due to heavy rains that cause the soil to turn to mud) with its head hanging down. The auroch remains there for centuries.

The cave is slanted slightly, perhaps from soaked soil (due to rain) and this is how the Auroch got stuck inside the cave - the soil was saturated from heavy rains and he sank. The Rune shape is in the shape of the Auroch's head/horns, but the Auroch had its head bent down, so it formed an upside down U shape (with its head/horns), since it got stuck inside the cave.

#### Questions

This rune also contains the first Egyptian hieroglyphic known as "Horizon," often depicted as the sun between two leopards or "Aker"<sup>7</sup>. The two leopards represent Kali and her twin sibling Tenko and the sun is what they saw when they woke up that morning by the Ur pool.



What information was given to people regarding Uranium<sup>8</sup>?

In order to prolong life  $\sim$  1-3 drops (by eye) annually.
